

4 TIPS TO HELP KEEP PETS SAFE AROUND MEDICATION

It's common for pets to get into human medications. Help keep your pet safe with these tips.



1 CHILD SAFE ≠ PET SAFE

Child-safe pill bottles may not mean pet-safe. Pets are known to chew through plastic pill vials, boxes, and blister packages.



2 STORE SECURELY

High places may not be secure. Consider cabinets that can't be nosed open.



3 KEEP SEPARATE

Store human and pet medications separately to prevent mix-ups.



4 DISCARD SAFELY

Dogs have been known to get into garbage, which can contain expired, unused, or unwanted medications.



ALWAYS CALL A VETERINARIAN

Call a veterinarian immediately if your pet eats medication of any kind!
